NYC DOT and MTA-NYCT will implement safety improvements along Union Square West between 17th St. and 14th St.:

- Create car-free pedestrian areas on Union Square West between 16th St. - 17th St. and 14th St. - 15th St.
- Maintain Union Square Market vendor access and space
- Maintain cobblestone paving between 14th St. and 15th St.

Implementation begins December 22nd



These projects are temporary to address the closure. Treatments that may potentially remain, if any, after the closure will undergo all appropriate reviews.
