NYC DOT and MTA-NYCT will implement a Shared Street on University Place between 14th St. and 13th St. where pedestrians and cyclists share space with slow-moving vehicles:

- Add curb extensions on University Place and 14th at southeast corner and southwest corner, and 13th at northwest corner and southeast corner
- Add pedestrian space and enhance pedestrian safety at crossing with shorter crosswalks
- Reconfigure roadway to slow traffic and allow for local drop-off access
- Traffic calming measures with advisory 5MPH speed limit signage
- Enhanced accessibility with detectable edge treatments
- Expand bikeshare capacity with more Citi Bike docks and create space for additional bike parking facilities

Implementation begins in November
